My work involves hand stitching in surface embroidery, crewel, petit point and often mixed media, e.g., acrylic, paint, silk dye, or crayon, with stitch. For background materials, I prefer 100% cottons, linens, silks and wool.

Currently I am involved in creating tiny theme books and sampler books as well as little boxes embellished with buttons, beads, found objects and a variety of specialty threads. As well, I enjoy creating new items from re-purposed felted wool using threads of wool and/or Perle cotton in plain or variegated colours.

I received my professional Teachers' Education at McGill University, BA at Trent University and Visual Arts Specialist Certificate from Queen's University. I am a member of the Embroiderers' Guild of Peterborough and the Embroiderers' Association of Canada. I have enjoyed teaching workshops for both groups.
